OSDC Pre PHP Day 2010

On the 23rd November 2010 Microsoft sponsored a one day focused PHP event occurring the day before the Open Source Developers Conference. The day was organised with a series of short talks and workshops.

The day was a success seeing attendees happy with the break-up of workshop demos and formal presentations. There was alot of discussion regarding a more PHP Australia wide community networking opportunities.

PHP Un-Confernece Sydney 2010

There was an un-conference held at Google Sydney office on the 16th of December 2010. The event was enjoyed by attendees and saw around 100 people gather in four groups across two rooms to discuss chosen PHP topics.

phpConf.au was born from the idea of wanting to for fill this gap by providing the community with a range of both professional learning and social avenues for networking opportunities.

Conference Set-Up

phpConf.au has been designed to reach a broad spectrum of attendees. In order to achieve this the layout will comprise of three streams across two main theatre rooms and one room set-up in a classroom layout for workshops.

To provide maximum coverage for sponsors there will be a trade show area in the main foyer, located between the two main theatre rooms and lunch area.

PHP Dinner Drinks

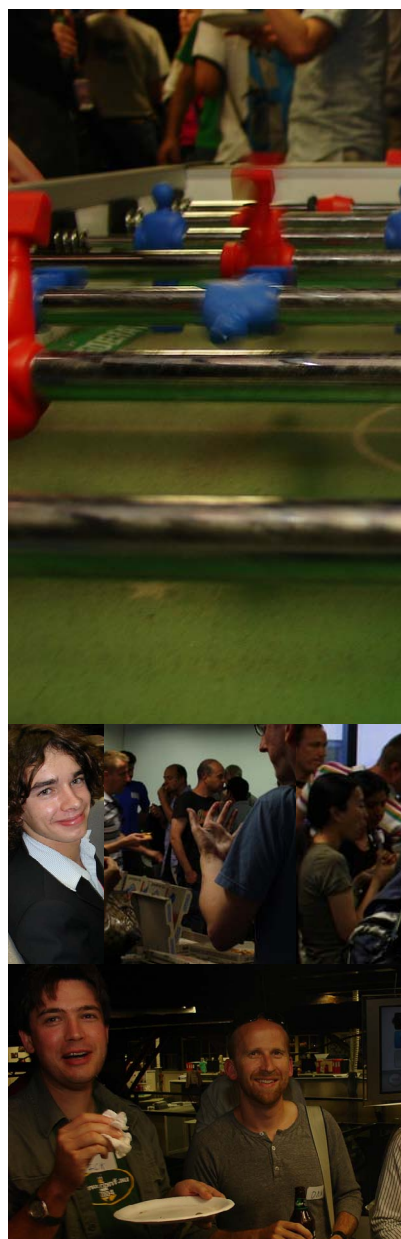
